a) School Report - Kory Sholdice, Principal & Susan Dillabough, Vice-Principal

- vii) School Chromebooks-now have 3 carts for the chromebooks
- viii) Agendas-brought in for Grades 2 & 3 only, council has helped in the past, Will the kids use them?-tabled until next meeting as cost of agendas is needed
- ix) YES (Youth Empowerment Support) program-Keira, presentations/programs/activities, No Secrets put on by the Child Advocacy Center
