5. Fundraisers

a)Fundraisers

i) Poinsettias-

• Penhold Crossing is running a poinsettia fundraiser for an internal group. Suggestion was made that all of the school admin could get together to discuss future fundraisers so as not to overlap or double-up again. Prices suggested to remain the same as past years-\$20 for the small ones and \$50 for the large ones. \$6.87 profit on the small, \$9.05 profit on the large.

b) Adopt A Family-

• The PAC adopts 2-3 families per year. Larger families with 4+ children. Fundraiser goes through Women's Outreach with a budget of about \$1400. There is a guideline for what you need to spend on food in gift cards and the rest is spent as desired. \$8900 in the general account that could go towards adopt a family. The suggestion is to try for 2-3 families with an attempt to get a local Penhold family.

c) Casino Spending-

- Trudy Henry presented a wish list from teachers including fine motor game sets, magnet sets, wiggle chairs and gym equipment. She also suggested new school tshirts, performance groups (which have seen an increase in price from \$600 up to \$800-1000), class sets of iPads or Chrome Books, or the Naturally Nurtured program with bunnies to help children understand emotions (costs about \$1500).
- A suggestion was put forward that a small budget could be allocated to each teacher to designate to their classroom as they see fit and needed. A decision was made to put the final choice over to a later meeting, as the casino funds have a two year window in which to be spent.
