

Welcome to Kindergarten!

Beginning in January, Chinook's Edge will be accepting Kindergarten registrations for the 2021-2022 school year. Children must turn five years old by December 31, 2021 to begin attending Kindergarten in the fall of 2021. Responding to Covid19 Symptoms—links below

Your Child Has COVID-19 Symptoms

Your child has one or more of these COVID-19 symptoms that are new, worsening or not related to other known causes: fever; cough; shortness of breath; loss of sense of smell or taste.

Your child is legally required* to isolate

A COVID-19 test is recommended

Your Child Has COVID-19 Symptoms

Your child has one or more of these COVID-19 symptoms that are new, worsening or not related to other known causes: Chills • Sore throat or painful swallowing • Runny nose or congestion • Feeling unwell or fatigued • Nausea or vomiting or diarrhea • Unexplained loss of appetite • Muscle or joint aches • Headache • Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

- Keep your child home if they are sick.
- If your child only has 1 of the above symptoms and no change in 24 hours they can attend school if they are well enough.
- If more symptoms arise or change to symptoms in the Red Square, it is recommended to get a COVID19 test and isolate until you get a negative result or all symptoms are gone.
