- YESS program from AHS to support social and emotional needs.

This year we have been focused on determining what each of our students need from us to be successful in the next steps of their learning journey. Our teachers and school staff are working tirelessly to address the impact of three consecutive years of learning disruptions. We are funneling our energy to ensure students have reached the essential outcomes and achieved the skills that are critical for their success at the next course level. Our teachers are experts in identifying, intervening and providing the supports a student may need.

Online Kindergarten Registration for the 2022-2023 school year begins on January 10!






Pre-Kindergarten Program

- ★ Pre-Kindergarten builds children's strengths and skills in a language rich, play-based environment for students who are three or four years of age.
- ★ Children are provided with educational activities to enhance their cognitive, emotional, social, creative, and physical development. Our pre-kindergarten program offers small class sizes.
- ★ The program is delivered by a certified teacher with the support from educational assistants. Speech Language Pathologist and Occupational Therapist also provide support to the Pre-Kindergarten class.
- ★ Pre-Kindergarten offers half-day programming three-four days each week throughout the school year.
- ★ We are accepting applications for community children who have mild moderate needs or no specialized need, however there is a charge of \$200 a month per child.
