- 5) Reports/Updates (15 minutes)
  - a) School Report Principal Kory Sholdice
- No Secrets No Secrets is a personal safety program for students in Kindergarten to Grade 4. Its objective is to prevent child sexual abuse & exploitation. No Secrets encourages children to develop respect for themselves and their bodies. Grade 1 and Kindergarten both have the presenters come to their class allowing the students to hear the message twice while they are at JDES.

- Playground Proposal Connected with Park n Play Design. The initial quote is \$45,140.38 before tax. This includes 2 Zero G seats (accessible) and delivery. It does include installation or the surfacing that will be needed below the zipline. We will work with the town or CESD to have the rock put in and likely have Park n Play install the equipment. Tim Aylesworth will be getting back to us with a more detailed quote.
- We will have two student teachers from RDP. They will be here on Wednesday for 3
  hours to focus on small groups and one to one interventions. The practicum will last 8
  weeks.
- School Assurance Survey Annual survey that gathers feedback on behalf of schools and school authorities to understand what works well and what needs improvement.
- Pink Shirt Day February 26th Focus on kindness and what that means.
- National Autism Day Wearing blue shirts and some age-appropriate lessons on what Autism is – April 2
- Messaging coming out tomorrow (Feb 13) about new VP who has been hired Danielle Booker. Official start date of March 3/25

#### b) **Teacher Report** – (10 minutes)

- Grade 1 In language arts we are done reviewing phonemic awareness with letters and sound now moving into digraphs and focusing on practicing blends. In math we are into the teen numbers with a big focus on addition and subtraction. After the break we are beginning our animal research projects which takes 3 weeks. One week of research, we then create a pop up book the following week, and build paper mache models of our animals (polar bear, arctic hare, and arctic fox).
- Grade 2: in phonics we are working on long vowels, ed and ing. We are working on adding more details to our sentences and building stamina in our writing. For reading we are working on comprehension. In Math we have been working on strategies for addition and subtraction as well as reading and building numbers up to 100. We have finished up Meteghan in SS and are starting Iqaluit. For Science we are working on light energy.
- Grade 3: Math Addition/Subtraction with and without regrouping
  - using varying strategies to find what is most efficient
  - basic facts
  - multiplication and division
  - L.A. Narrative writing, focusing on the parts
    - Comprehension strategies
    - Writing and editing strategies
    - Journal writing, directed writing

Science - Energy (Forces)

Social - Culture in varying countries and comparing and contrasting to our life in Canada, Learning about different regions in the countries
